

Here are a few conversation lines you can use for any voter who chooses not to vote at all or for Biden.






California Girls General Meeting

The speakers agreed California was a beautiful state, but the political changes have made the state less enjoyable. Reasons were homeless encampments, squatters, open drug use, trash and debris, Proposition 47 approval, causing epidemic trends of smash and grab crimes when the felony was changed to a misdemeanor, if less than \$950 were stolen. Benefits of phone apps: Life After California, and the Next-Door app were discussed. The state, dotted with "sparkling cities were slowly falling apart." After a period, each speaker in search of a "better life" moved to Texas. Moving was difficult when leaving homes, jobs, family, and friends behind but have come to appreciate and call Longview, Texas home.


