


The President's Talking Point-Jennifer Kranzman



STANDING RULES

Republican Women of Gregg County

1. All standing rules will be reviewed and voted on annually.
2. The Executive officers and President's tenure will be January 1 through December 31 each calendar year.
3. Dues shall be \$40.00 annually for Primary Members and \$15.00 for Associates.
4. All materials, printed or otherwise, must be approved by the President of RWGC or the President's designee before being distributed. Any advertising: whether in print, social media, radio, or television including but not limited to Public Service Announcements shall likewise be reviewed and approved by RWGC President or the President's designee prior to any form of dissemination.
5. Any Executive Committee member, Chairman or Club member, except the President, who has expenses of over \$50.00 shall obtain the President's approval before making the expenditure. Expenses over \$100.00 shall require Executive Committee approval.
6. The Benevolence Chair shall send a \$50.00 Memorial or flowers (whichever is appropriate) to honor a deceased club member or in the event of a member's loss of a spouse or child.
7. Each Committee Chair will keep a procedure notebook with details of all projects of said committee. (Notebook to include but not limited to names of persons participating on the committee, supplies used, cost of supplies, fees incurred for entry fees, booth rental, etc.) Notebooks will be returned to the President who will present them to the Finance committee for the purpose of budget preparation.
8. Each Committee Chair shall present a budget estimate of projects to the Finance Committee for preparation of the annual budget. Estimated budget forms will be available from the President or Treasurer. The annual budget must be approved by the Executive Board and the Club.
9. The Treasurer will prepare and present a summary financial statement of income and disbursements for each calendar year.
10. The Vice-President of Membership will prepare and have the annual directory ready to be published to the club's website by the March meeting.
11. The club is not a federal PAC; therefore, no platform or campaign speeches may be given at club meetings by federal candidates. An elected official may speak regarding his/her office.
12. Raffles are prohibited.
13. The sale of alcohol is prohibited unless the seller holds a current license issued by the Texas Alcoholic Beverages Commission for the purpose of selling alcoholic beverages.
14. No sales tax will be collected for items sold through Club silent auctions.
15. Members are expected to act with civility in both word and deed toward one another. It is expected that this be practiced in both word and deed with any type of communication. Attacking, blaming, back biting, gossiping, or disruptive behavior toward RWGC members

16. endangers our club's environment and growth, adversely affecting the efforts which have built our membership. Our club culture should be one of trust, acceptance and professionalism. Members should strive to practice "if you have nothing nice to say, say nothing". Persistent inappropriate behavior is not acceptable and will not be tolerated. Continued non-compliance will lead to a written warning and possible removal from membership by board decision.




